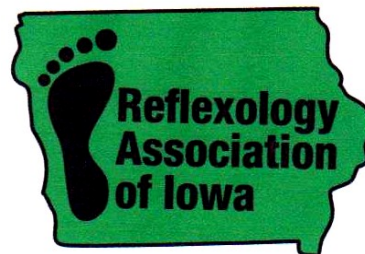

## History of RAIA - Reflexology Association of Iowa

---

The Iowa Association of Reflexology was formed in 2002 to educate, promote, and protect Reflexology in Iowa. Pat Barrance, Marcia Lenning, and other founding members of the Association worked diligently to protect Iowa Reflexology. After many lengthy and often frustrating trips to the State House and a Public Hearing at the Department of Health, reflexology was exempt from Massage Licensing on March 30, 2004 (HF2201).

In April 2008 the Association was re-organized under new bylaws and a new name, the Reflexology Association of Iowa - RAIA. Articles of Incorporation were filed in June 2008 and our application for nonprofit status was approved in February 2010. As of February 2009 the RAIA was granted State Affiliation by the Reflexology Association of America - RAA.

RAIA offers two types :

Associate Membership is open to Individuals who are non-certified Reflexologists, students in training, and agencies who support the growth and development of the field of reflexology. Associate members may not vote or hold office in the organization.

Professional Membership is open to individuals who have completed their training (200 hours) and are certified by their reflexology school or by a national non-profit testing board. Professional members will have the right to vote and hold office in the organization.
